The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Ken Taylor.

- All members must respect coaches, officials, volunteers and their decisions
